India-UK Business School Dialogue 16-17 September 2025



AMDISA and Chartered Association of Business Schools (CABS), UK have agreed to establish a strategic framework for a formal dialogue between UK and Indian business schools with the aim of increasing transnational education activity between them, beginning with a two-day conference event in New Delhi in September 2025.

The inaugural **India-UK Business School Dialogue** will bring together Deans, Directors and Vice Chancellors from Indian and UK business schools to build mutually beneficial and long-lasting Transnational Education (TNE) partnerships.

Being launched by the UK's Chartered Association of Business Schools, the dialogue is supported by the British Council who will be hosting a Stakeholder Reception on Monday 15 September 2025 for delegates, and the wider higher education community.
